

QUITCLAIM DEED WITHOUT COVENANT

 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT VALENTINE M. JONES, of Brunswick, County of Cumberland and State of Maine, in and for consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration paid by THOMAS E. JONES, whose mailing address is P.O. Box 8, Brunswick, Maine, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby remise, release, bargain, sell and convey and forever quit-claim unto the said THOMAS E. JONES, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

A certain lot or parcel of land, with the buildings thereon, situated in Brunswick, County of Cumberland and State of Maine, on the Southerly side of Pleasant Street, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point at the intersection of the southerly line of Pleasant Street and the easterly line of land of Edith A. Thompson, and running in a southerly direction, one hundred fifty (150) feet, more or less, to the northerly line of land of Aveline Messier; thence running easterly on said Messier's Northerly line, sixty-nine (69) feet to land formerly of Frank O. Stanwood; thence running northerly along said Stanwood westerly line, one hundred fifty (150) feet, more or less, to the south line of Pleasant Street; thence running westerly sixty-nine (69) feet on the southerly line of Pleasant Street, to the place of beginning, together with a right of way eight and one-half (8 1/2) feet wide and eighty-five and sixty-five hundredths (85.65) feet long on land of Edith A. Thompson which lies adjacent to the westerly line of above conveyed land, which said right of way is one now in common use.

Being the same premises conveyed to the Grantor and Grantee herein by deed of Norman A. Davis, recorded in the Cumberland County Registry of Deeds.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, to the said THOMAS E. JONES, his heirs and assigns forever.
